


Today's Healthcare Climate

- However, this is still a political hot topic and there are still possibilities for further reform or repeal of the law.

Good News for DV Survivors!

- On March 30, 2010 President Obama signed a health reform reconciliation bill, putting the final touches on a new law that offers significant benefits to victims of domestic violence.
- The new health reform law means that it is illegal for health insurers to deny coverage to victims of domestic violence because they consider their abuse to be a preexisting condition.



Preexisting Conditions

 Beyond not being able to use DV as an reason to deny a victim health benefits, the Affordable Care Act also prevents insurance companies from denying anyone health benefits based on any preexisting condition.
