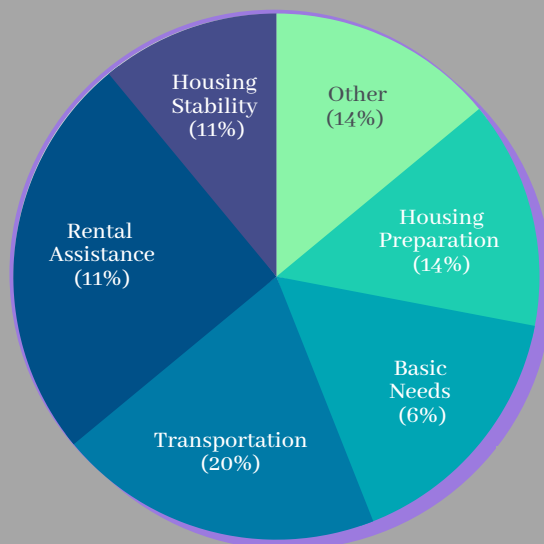
Ballmer Group's investment for COVID-19 support in August of 2020 made flexible financial assistance available to four of our eastern Washington member programs providing DV Housing First services.

"Survivor fled the area due to DV/SA, however, when COVID hit she lost her job and was forced to move back. FFA was used to help with move-in costs and now the Survivor is settled in her home with her young children and working."
